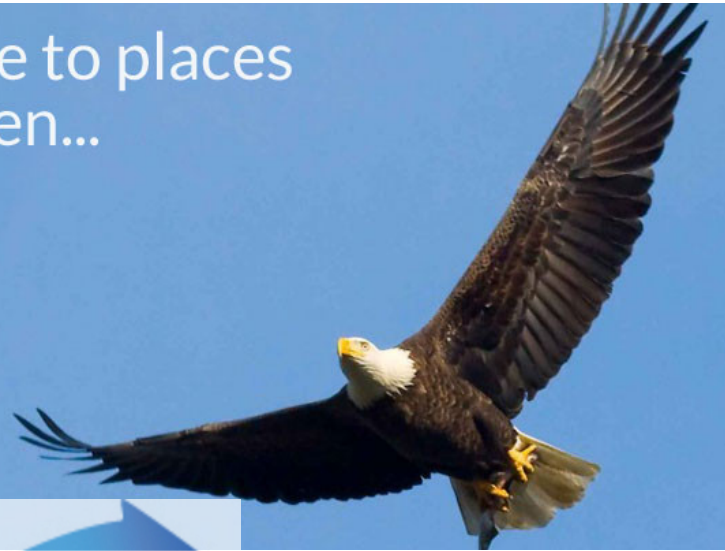

Global Leaders are individuals who effect significant positive change [...] by building communities through the development of trust and the arrangement of organisational structures and processes in a context involving multiple cross-boundary stakeholders, multiple sources of external cross-boundary authority, and multiple cultures under conditions of temporal, geographical and cultural complexity.
(Mendenhall 2008:17)



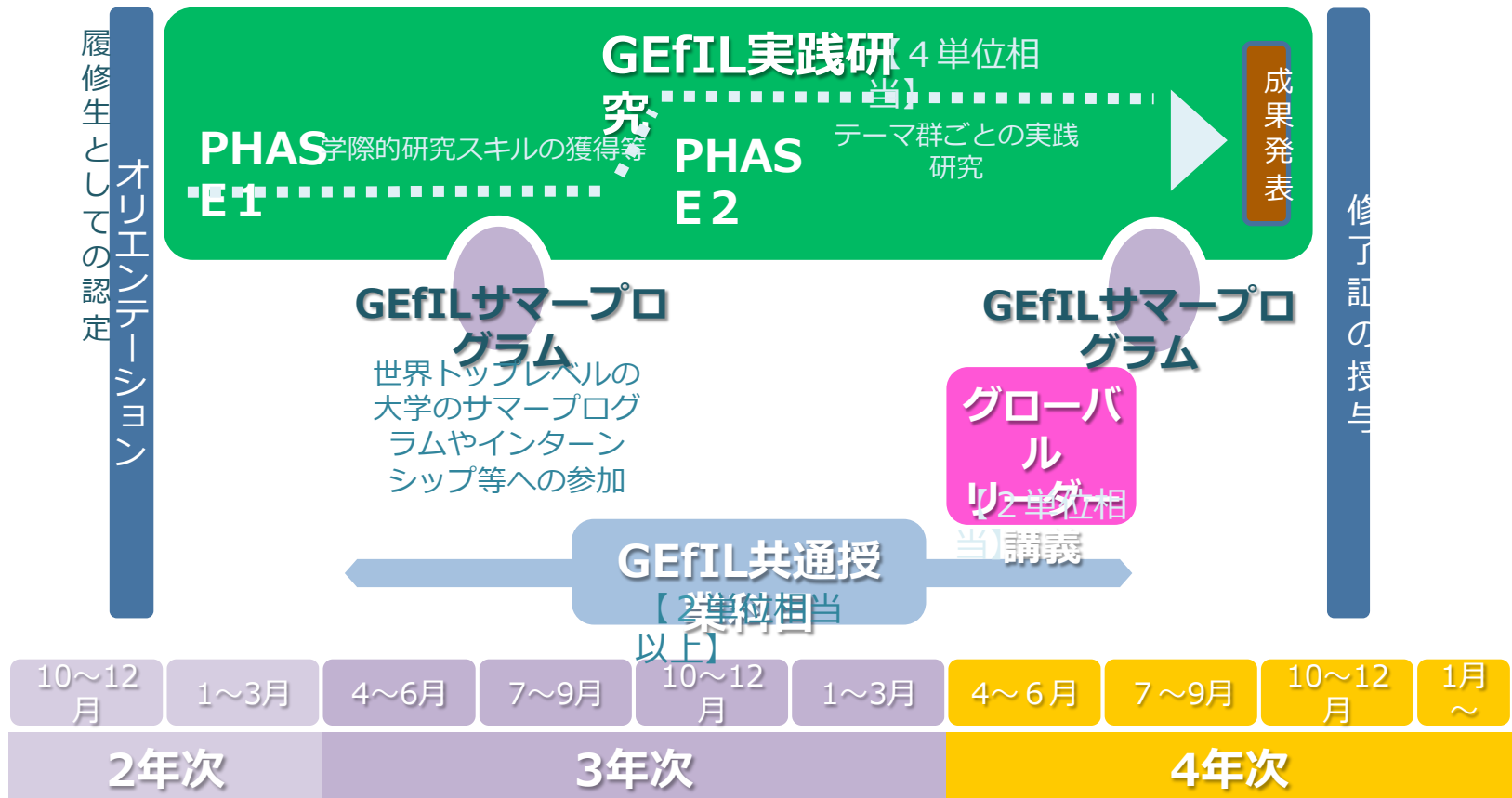
The GEfIL Elements:
