2023 GEfIL Spring Abroad Program “Taiwan’s Dilemma in the Asia-Pacific Region”

Organized by Humanities Research Center, National Chengchi University, R.O.C.
(Taiwan) & GLP-GEfIL Office of the University of Tokyo, Japan

Course Description

In today’s world, Taiwan has been recognized as one of the most advanced democratic states. The process of Taiwan’s democratization during the last three decades proves to be a successful one, because of the establishment of a transparent, people-centered, and highly functional political system.

While enjoying its political freedom, human rights protection, and sound economic management, Taiwan has attracted worldwide attention during the last three years, mainly for the vulnerability of its sovereignty, under the threats of its neighboring countries’ military powers. Since the Russia-Ukraine war was waged in February 2022, the uncertainty of Taiwan’s sovereignty has been widely discussed and speculated. As Taiwan and Japan are close neighbors and share common values, it will be irresponsible to turn a blind eye to Taiwan’s dilemma and to ignore the geo-political tensions in the Asia-Pacific region that will inevitably affect Japan.

Specially designed for University of Tokyo’s GEfIL students who aim for “global leadership,” this NCCU Spring Program shall provide insightful knowledge about Taiwan’s historical, political, legal, and societal transformation, in order make the students ready for unexpected confrontations in the Asia-Pacific region. This program will focus on nine topics:

- (1) History of Taiwan’s Political Systems,
- (2) Democracy and Democratization in Taiwan,
- (3) The Event of 2.28,
- (4) The Strength and Weakness of Taiwan’s Democracy,
- (5) Japanese Colonial Heritage in Contemporary Taiwan,
- (6) “Two Chinas” and the Japan-Taiwan Relations in the Post-war Era,
- (7) Indigenous Movements and Efforts of Reconciliation in Taiwan,
- (8) Taiwan: the Gateway to the Indo-Pacific Region, and
- (9) National Defense of R. O. C. (Taiwan)

These lectures will be taught by NCCU’s scholars who all obtained PhD at universities of the US and the UK as well as government officials and politicians.

This Spring Program also offers various opportunities to visit governmental agencies,

oppositional party's offices, museums, and cultural heritages. There is a possibility that GEfIL students can meet and talk to Audrey Tang, the Digital Minister of Taiwan.

This Program consists of three components: ① lectures & discussion, ② visits and fieldwork, and ③ cultural exchanges with local and international students at NCCU.
