Selection of candidates is based on screening of application documents and an interview in English. Interviews for applicants, who passed the first screening, will be held in late May.

In Summer 2015, the International NGO Peace Boat will conduct its 2nd Special Global University Programme, a short-term intensive programme offered in English and aimed at young, talented future leaders from the Asia-Pacific region. The subject of the 2015 programme is "Re-Defining Security: Is Common Human Security Possible in Asia?" The curriculum offers a unique combination of fieldwork in Cebu, Singapore and Mumbai with workshops and lectures on board and culminates in drawing up an action plan. It is designed to equip students wishing to work for international institutions and the third sector, with the first-hand knowledge, skills and experiences needed to contribute actively to the solution of pressing global issues.

The curriculum will consist of five units as below:
1: National Security, Human Security, and Common Security

2: State Stability and Conflict Cycle (field visit in Cebu)

3: Multiethnic Country in its 50th year - Migrants and Human Security (field visit in Singapore)

4: Human Security in Emerging States (field visit in Mumbai)

5: Action Plan "Towards Common Human Security in the Asia-Pacific"

The number of participants is limited to around 25 undergraduate and postgraduate students from Japan, India, China and ASEAN countries.

Participants will travel on the 88th Peace Boat Global Voyage departing from Yokohama on 21 August 2015 and sailing to Mumbai (India). On the way, the group will undertake fieldwork in Cebu, Singapore and Mumbai. The programme ends on 9 September in Mumbai; participants are scheduled to return to Japan on 10 September.
